


1st WORLD CUP for Women « JEANNOT VEDRINE » Saint-Vulbas (France) February 11th and 12th



AGREEMENT PROTCOL

Nations' World Cup for Women « Jeannot Védrine »

<u>QUALIFICATION</u> : 12 nations

According to the performances on 3 games (PRECISION THROW, DOUBLE, and FAST THROW IN PAIRS) during the Women World Championship in Casablanca in October 2016.

- **1.** The best nation of each continent, Asia and Oceania being put together.
- 2. The organizing nation if it is not part of the above list.
- **3.** This list shall be completed to a total of 10 nations in the order of their position in the results of the World Championship and on three reference games.
- 4. The Organizing Committee may invite two nations that are not part of the preceding list.
- **5.** If necessary, the list can be completed up to 12 nations in the same conditions as in #3.

DRAW: Friday February 10, 2017 at 6 pm in the bowls area « Jeannot Védrine » by the Technical Commissioner of the FIB in the presence of the International Referee.

TECHNICAL ORGANIZATION

<u>PARTICIPANTS</u>: 12 teams of 4 players maximum.

DEVELOPMENT OF THE COMPETITION:

• DIRECT CONFRONTATION BETWEEN THE NATIONS:

- \blacktriangleright 4 groups of 3 teams.
- ➤ In each group, all the teams meet. Therefore, each team plays two games.
- > Possibility for the teams to swap players for each game.
- > For every game, a victory gives 2 points, a draw 1 point, and a defeat 0 point.
- If there is a draw at the end of the 3 games, there will be a decisive game with the rules of the Bowl Throw Game with a target placed in the middle of the valid rectangle for the jack throw :
 - 2 bowls and 2 throws (target: white jack). A draw will decide whether the players first bowl or throw. The order in which they play is decided by a draw.
 - If the tie persists, the game will be played again in the same conditions (players, running order and alternation) and will stop when the tie no longer exists.
- The 4 teams that are graded 1st in each group are qualified for the semi-finals. In case of a draw between the 3 teams of a group, these teams will play a decisive game as it is explained above.

• MEETING BETWEEN TWO TEAMS:

> 1st Round: PRECISION THROW

- Direct confrontation between the two players. The order in which they throw will be drawn.
- A draw is possible.
- ➢ 2nd Round: DOUBLE
 - Duration of the games: 13 points or an hour and a half. A draw is possible.
 - It is possible to swap one player during a game.


➢ 3rd Round: FAST THROW IN PAIRS

• Direct confrontation between the two teams. A draw is possible.

A player can participate in all the games.

• CONSTITUTION OF THE GROUPS:

- **1.** Establish the rank of the teams from 1 to 12, based on the performances during the 2016 World Championship in these 3 games.
- **2.** Place the first 4 teams in the following grid (position A).



- **3.** Make 2 hats: hat 1, the teams ranked 5 to 8 and hat 2 those ranked 9 to 12.
- **4.** Complete the groups by drawing one team from each hat.
- **5.** Order of the meetings: 1st Phase: B against C

- 2nd Phase: A against the loser of B-C

- 3rd Phase: A against the winner of B-C

COMMENT: Duration of the warm-out session: > Double: 10 minutes,

- \blacktriangleright Precision Throw: 5 minutes,
- ▶ Fast Throw in Pairs: 3 minutes.

Rank: A ranking of the Nations will be established for each game and the first teams will be rewarded.

Expenses will be paid by the organization from arrival to Monday, 13 February 2017 at 02:00 pm.


<u>Rewards</u>: They will be provided by the organizers.
