**AGREEMENT PROTOCOL  
Nations' World Cup for Women**

**QUALIFICATION: 12 nations**

According to the performances on 4 games (DOUBLE, BOWL THROW GAME, PRECISION THROW and FAST THROW IN PAIRS) during the Women World Championship in Jiaxing (China) in October 2018.

1. The best nation of each continent, Asia and Oceania being put together.
2. The organizing nation if it is not part of the above list.
3. This list shall be completed to a total of 10 nations in the order of their position in the results of the World Championship and on three reference games.
4. The Organizing Committee may invite two nations that are not part of the preceding list.
5. If necessary, the list can be completed up to 12 nations in the same conditions as in #3.

# TECHNICAL ORGANIZATION

**PARTICIPANTS:** 12 teams of 4 players maximum.

## **DEVELOPMENT OF THE COMPETITION:**

### • **DIRECT CONFRONTATION BETWEEN THE NATIONS:**

- 4 groups of 3 teams. In each group, all the teams meet. Therefore, each team plays two games.
- Possibility for the teams to swap players for each game.
- For every game, a victory gives 2 points, a draw 1 point, and a defeat 0 point.
- The 4 teams that are graded 1<sup>st</sup> in each group are qualified for the semi-finals. In case of a draw between 2 or the 3 teams of a group, these teams will play a decisive game with the rules of the Bowl Throw Game with a target placed in the middle of the valid rectangle for the jack throw :
  - 2 bowls and 2 throws (target: white jack). A draw will decide whether the players first bowl or throw. The order in which they play is decided by a draw.
  - If the tie persists, the game will be played again in the same conditions (players, running order and alternation) and will stop when the tie no longer exists.
- If there is a draw at the end of a qualifying match (semi-final or final), the teams are separated by the decisive game as it is explained above.

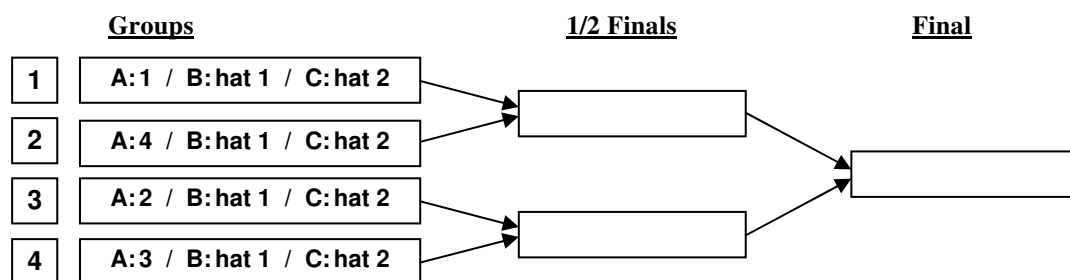
### • **MEETING BETWEEN TWO TEAMS:**

- **1<sup>st</sup> Round: FAST THROW IN PAIRS**
  - Direct confrontation between the two teams. A draw is possible.
- **2<sup>nd</sup> Round: PRECISION THROW**
  - Direct confrontation between the two players. A draw is possible.
- **3<sup>rd</sup> Round: DOUBLE and BOWL THROW GAME**
  - ⇒ **DOUBLE:**
    - Duration of the games: 13 points or an hour and a half. A draw is possible.
    - It is possible to swap one player during a game.
  - ⇒ **BOWL THROW GAME:**
    - In 8 ends. A draw is possible.

***A player can participate in all the games.***

### • **CONSTITUTION OF THE GROUPS:**

1. Establish the rank of the teams from 1 to 12, based on the performances during the 2018 World Championship in these 4 games.
2. Place the first 4 teams in the following grid (position A).



3. Make 2 hats: hat 1, the teams ranked 5 to 8 and hat 2 those ranked 9 to 12.
4. Complete the groups by drawing one team from each hat.
5. Order of the meetings:
  - 1<sup>st</sup> Phase: B against C
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> Phase: A against the loser of B-C
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> Phase: A against the winner of B-C

**COMMENT:** Duration of the warm-out session: ➤ *Double and Bowl Throw Game: 10 minutes,*  
➤ *Precision Throw: 5 minutes,*  
➤ *Fast Throw in Pairs: 3 minutes.*

Rank: A ranking of the Nations will be established for each game and the first teams will be rewarded.
